CRB CHECKS

Certain types of employment and professions are exempt from the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 and in those cases particularly where the employment is sought in relation to positions involving working with children or vulnerable adults, details for all criminal convictions must be given. The information given will be treated in the strictest of confidence and only taken into account where, in the reasonable opinion of the NHS, the offence is relevant to the post to which you are applying.

Failure to declare a conviction may result in the termination of employment if the offence is not declared but later comes to light.

The cost of the CRB check is £100.00 including administration fees and this will be paid in full by max20 Ltd. However if you do not take up the offer of employment then you will be liable to repay the cost (excluding administration fees) back to max20 Ltd.
